Monday

Scripture: 2 Peter 1:12-21

Question: Can you remember the last time you gave an eyewitness testimony about something

God had done for you? What was it and who did you share it with?

Tuesday

Scripture: Matthew 17:1-13

Question: Jesus tells the three disciples who went up on the mountain that day to keep a secret.

Do you think you could have kept that secret? Why or why not?

Wednesday

Scripture: Mark 8:22-33

Question: In yesterday's reading, we find Jesus telling some disciples to keep a secret about what

happened on the mountain. Today is a reading where Jesus tells Peter not to tell anyone about him. Why do you think he wanted to keep this from the people?

Thursday

Scripture: Acts 1:1-11

Question: Jesus foretells the gift of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, telling the people gathered

around him that they will be witnesses to the ends of the earth. Where has been the farthest you were away from home, when you told someone about how God had

provided for you?

Friday

Scripture: Romans 10:1-15

Question: Have you ever felt the way Paul is describing those who are sharing the good news

from our reading today? Do you have beautiful feet?

Saturday

Scripture: 2 Timothy 1:1-14

Question: Sometimes offering a testimony is difficult and we might want to hold back in certain

circumstances. How can today's reading encourage you to share with those around

you?
