Monday

Scripture: Isaiah 35:1-10

Question: Isaiah gives a vision of a restored Israel and relates it to strange things in a desert. Can

you think of a time in your life when you felt like you were in a desert? What was that

like?

Tuesday

Scripture: Matthew 11:2-11

Question: Jesus speaks about John the Baptist being a witness, a messenger to prepare the way.

How can you prepare the way for Jesus' return today?

Wednesday

Scripture: Isaiah 61:1-3

Question: Jesus quotes the words of Isaiah from this morning and asks us to do the same. Is

there a space in your life where you need to speak out against injustices, freeing those

who have been oppressed? Where are you being called?

Thursday

Scripture: 1 Peter 2:9-12

Question: Witnessing to our faith concerns so much more than the words we speak, it is in how

we live out our lives. If people were to observe your life, what would they understand

as your witness to God?

Friday

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 9:19-23

Question: Paul witnessed to many about his faith in Jesus. In our passage this morning, we find

him talking about becoming "like" others so they may hear the message. What does

this mean to you, is it just becoming "relatable," or is there more to it?

Saturday

Scripture: Luke 6:46-49

Question: As you reflect on your witness this week, have you been challenged in your actions or

words? How do you plan on changing your ways?
