**Monday**

Scripture: Leviticus 19:18-37

Question: The book of Leviticus can be difficult to read at times, but in our passage from today, we find one of the greatest commands, to love our neighbors. When you reflect on the laws written in this chapter, what comes to mind about loving others?

**Tuesday**

Scripture: Psalm 133

Question: In our Psalm today, we find words about unity. How can loving our neighbors bring unity? What holds us back?

**Wednesday**

Scripture: Matthew 5:33-48

Question: In what ways can you show love for an enemy? Is this even possible?

**Thursday**

Scripture: Luke 6:27-42

Question: It is frequently easy to love those who love us, but can you show love in certain ways to those who don't love you? In what ways have you experienced that in your life?

**Friday**

Scripture: John 13:18-38

Question: What would it look like if we love people the way Jesus loved them?

**Saturday**

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 13

Question: Paul wrote a letter to the church in Corinth, and although we hear the words often during weddings, they were written about disagreements within the church. He tells us how we can love each other, even in the midst of disagreements. How can you indwell his view in our life today?
