Monday

Scripture: Revelation 3:7-22

Question: In one of the letters written to 7 churches in Revelation, Jesus says that the name of

God will be written on them. If people looked at you today, whose name would they

say is written on you?

Tuesday

Scripture: Luke 10:1-20

Question: Even in the midst of the power the Holy Spirit gives, we are to focus our joy in the

fact of who we are. Do you have trouble celebrating who you are versus what you are

able to do? Why?

Wednesday

Scripture: Acts 11:19-30

Question: Barnabas and Saul were together in Antioch, building the church and making disciples

of Jesus. This is where the people became known as Christians. Can you think of when

you first took that name for yourself? How did you feel about it?

Thursday

Scripture: Matthew 18:10-20

Question: In Toy Story 2, Buzz finds himself going all the way to Al's Toy Barn to rescue

Woody. How far did God need to go in order to rescue you?

Friday

Scripture: Galatians 6:1-10

Question: Woody needed to be reminded that he was a toy in the second Toy Story, that his

place was to make kids happy by being there for them to play with. This was "doing

good." How are you created to "do good" in your life today?

Saturday

Scripture: Hebrews 8:1-13

Question: If God's name is inscribed on you, how can you live your life exemplifying God's seal

on your life?
